Overview

URL entries with lastmod/changefreq/priority, image/video/news extensions and hreflang alternates. Auto-splits past 50,000 URLs into an index. Emits XML and Next.js sitemap.ts objects.

NOTE

When to use — Generating `sitemap.xml` from your routes without repeating your domain on every row.

Package: @lacspace/sitemap · v1.1.0

Kit: SEO Kit — everything crawlers & AI read

Runtime: zero dependencies

Install

```
npm i @lacspace/sitemap
```

Quick example

```
sitemap([{ loc, priority: 1.0, changefreq: "daily" }])
```

Returns: `<?xml ... urlset>`

Tips & warnings

TIP

`sitemapForSite(site.config, paths)` derives absolute URLs from your `defineSite()` config.

TIP

For a blog/docs, map your content list into the paths array so every page is indexed.

TIP

Zero-dependency and isomorphic — safe to import on the server, in the browser, on the edge and in React Native. It tree-shakes, so you only ship what you import.
